

The Year End Annual Meeting of the Moweaqua Village Council was called to order by Mayor Ruot leading in the Pledge to the Flag. Neece made the motion to approve the Year End Bills to be Paid with additions and corrections, Conlin seconded. Council voting Yes: Neece, Henry, Maynard, Lower, Reschke, and Conlin. No: None.

Finance Committee Chairman Mike Reschke explained that the next three items on the agenda pertain to accounting and need to be approved before the end of the Fiscal Year. Reschke made the motion to reimburse General Fund \$26,484.30 from the Telephone Utility Account for property maintenance wages, new trees, tree and stump removal, sidewalks and drainage equipment for the Fiscal Year 2016-2017, Neece seconded. Council voting Yes: Neece, Henry, Maynard, Lower, Reschke, and Conlin. No: None.

After the Year End business concluded, the newly elected Officials were asked to come forward to be sworn into their respective offices. D. Boomer Neece was sworn in as Village President for a four year term. Marcia Maynard, Joann Lower and Dana Shuster were sworn in as Trustees for four year terms.
